Sub: Policy for leasing of parcel space of Brakevans (SLRs), Assistant Guard's Cabin (AGC) and Parcel Vans (VPHs/VPs/VPU) - Clarification to leave/ non-loading rules.

Ref: (i). 'Comprehensive Parcel Leasing Policy' Board's letter No. 2006/TC(FM)/10/1 dated 28.03.2006 - Freight Marketing Circular No. 12 of 2006.

(ii). Freight Marketing Circular No. 05 of 2009 vide Board's letter No. 2007/TC(FM)/10/12 dated 25.02.2009.

- 1.0 Vive Board's instructions (ii) above, clarification has been issued in regard to provisions of leave/ non-loading contained in para (Z)-2, (Z)-3 and (Z)-8 of 'Comprehensive Parcel Leasing Policy (CPLP)' circulated vide Board's letter No. 2006/TC(FM)/10/1 dated 28.03.2006 under Freight Marketing Circular No. 12 of 2006.
- 2.0 The instructions contained in Freight Marketing Circular No. 05 of 2009 under Board's letter No. 2007/TC(FM)/10/12 dated 25.02.2009 are superceded by following instructions :-
 - 2.1 A maximum of one day's leave {as contained in para (Z)-2, (Z)-3 should be allowed only after completion of 30 days of lease operations.
 - 2.2 In case of leased Parcel Vans on round trip basis, leave as contained in para (Z)-2 of leasing policy and one day non-loading per week as contained in para (Z)-8 of leasing policy may be allowed for round trip as well as one-way. However, in case of one way leave/non-loading, the VP at other-end may be provided subject to availability of VP and position of supply. There will be no guarantee to supply VP in case of one way leave/non-loading. One way leave/non-loading may be permitted either by originating railway or destination railway. However, the facility of non-loading will be lapsed, if not availed during a week.
- 3.0 The above instructions will be made applicable for all leasing contracts existing as well as future contracts.
- 4.0 These instructions must be followed by all concerned with immediate effect.
