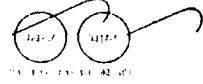

Sub: Tenth Report of RCC (2014) on "Scrap Disposal in Indian Railways".


Railway Convention Committee (2014) vide Observations and Recommendation no.1 of Part II contained in Tenth Report (extract enclosed) have pointed out that despite existence of a well laid down system of sorting out and disposal of scrap, there are sporadic instances of non- verification of stock due to relative inadequacy of stock verifiers and voluminous nature of material.

Board has expressed concern on the issue and desire that the position on your Railway/ unit may be reviewed to ensure strict adherence to provision on stock verification contained in chapter 32 of Indian Railway code for Stores Department Vol II and specifically para 3202 SII which lays down the frequency of stock verification.

Further, to ensure appropriate disposal of scrap a special drive may be launched to identify the areas where voluminous nature stock of Cast iron, Turnings and Boring, Rolling scrap, Non- ferrous scrap, Condemned Wagons, Coaches and Locos etc. which have not been verified and to depute special staff from the existing strength to pull up arrears of stock verification, if any.

In the above regard it is desired that :

- A feedback on the factual status and action taken may be invariably sent for Board's information **within a month i.e. by 20.2.17.**
- A report on the arrears in stock verification in terms of para 3202 SII which have lead to non disposal of scrap on your Railway/unit and the action taken to pull up arrears may also be **sent every month through MCDO addressed to FC (Railways) w.e.f. February'2017.**
