Kindly refer to your Railway's letter dt. 26.08.2016 wherein it was mentioned that Sh. Rajendra Kumar and others have filed a contempt petition before the Hon'ble Tribunal, Ernakulam and it is further learnt that the hearing in the case is coming up on 23.09.2016. The Review Petition filed against the dismissal of SLP No. 33654/2014 in the matter of UOI Vs K.S. Rajendra and others has also been dismissed on 23.08.2016 by the Hon'ble Apex Court.

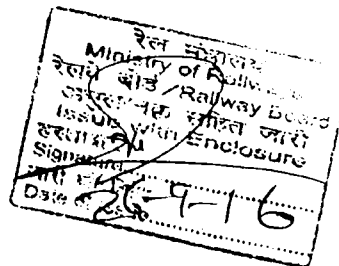
In view of the dismissal of the Review Petition and since no further legal recourse is available and the Rules governing the stepping up of pay have not been struck down by the Court, the Board has decided to implement the directions of the Court *ad personam* in the case of Sh. K. S. Rajendra and others. Board has also decided that the Zonal Railways may continue to contest the other cases pending before various courts of law on the subject of stepping up of pay of Loco Inspectors, defending the extant Rules on the subject issued by the Ministry of Finance, DoP&T and this Ministry and also upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the matter of UOI Vs. O.P. Saxena.

Action may be taken accordingly under intimation to this office.
