Subject:- Revision of rates of Night Duty Allowance in the revised (IV PC) scales of pay.

....

The question of revising the rates of Night Duty Allowance in the context of the recommendations of the IV Pay Commission vide para 26.13 of Chapter 26 of their Report has been considered by the Government in consultation with the Staff Side in the National Council of the Joint Consultative Machinery and the Departmental Council (Railways).

2. The President is pleased to decide that with effect from 1.10.1988 the rates of Night Duty Allowance per weighted hour of night duty for 'continuous', 'intensive' and 'excluded' categories of staff shall be revised as in Annexure-'A'. The rates of Night Duty Allowance per weighted hour of night duty in respect of 'essentially intermittent' staff shall be as in Annexure-'B'.

3. These rates are inclusive of Dearness Allowance sanctioned in this Ministry's letter No.PC-IV/86/DA/1 dated 12.10.1988.

4. These rates shall remain in force until further orders. The instructions contained in this Ministry's letter No.E(P&A)II-81/JCM(DG)/1000A dated 12.10.1988-are hereby superseded.

5. The other terms and conditions for sanction of Night Duty Allowance shall remain unchanged.

6. This has the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
