
**Sub: Counting of training period for purpose of Privilege/
Post-retirement Pass .**

In terms of Board's letters No. F(E)III-79-PN1/20 dated 17.04.1984 and 13.10.1986, training period of Group C and D employees who are required to undergo departmental training relating to jobs before they are put on regular employment, is treated as qualifying service for pension, if training is followed immediately by an appointment.

It is clarified that these provisions are applicable for the purpose of determining the eligibility of class/scale of Passes also subject to the conditions laid down in the Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 (2nd Edition 1993) and other instructions issued on the subject from time to time.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.
