Sub: Grant of privilege passes to railway servants
who take up appointment in other Central Government
Departments/Offices/Autonomous Bodies etc., on being
selected on the basis of their applications forwarded
by Railway Administrations.

In continuation of their letter No. E(NG)II68AP/6 dated
16.6.1971, the Railway Board have decided that permanent
railway servants and temporary railway servants with more than
three years continuous railway service, whose applications
have been forwarded and who have been selected and appointed
for posts in other Central Government Department/Offices,
Public Sector Undertakings or Autonomous Bodies, may be
allowed benefit of passes/PTOs for period of two years from
the date of relief from the railways, during which they are
permitted to retain their lien or position on the Railways,
as in the case of railway servants going on sponsored
deputation/foreign service, in terms of Board's letter
No. E(Trg)I66PS5-15/2 dated 11.10.1966 as further amended
from time to time.


