Sub: Rail travel facilities to MR/MOS(R)/DMR

There has been an incongruity in the existing Pass Rules in as much as they do not have any provision for travel facilities admissible to MR/MOS(R)/DMR during their tenure in Railways. To remove this incongruity, it has been decided by the ministry of Railways (Railway Board) that serving MR/MOS(R)/DMR may be extended the facility of Railway passes, on duty and while not on duty, on the same lines as available to serving Board Members.

Accordingly, Ministry of Railways are pleased to amend the Railway Servants (Pass) Rules, 1986 as in the ACS No.12 enclosed.

This issues with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of the Ministry of Railways.

ADVANCE CORRECTION SLIP NO.12 TO THE RAILWAY  
SERVANTS(PASS) RULES, 1986 (2<sup>ND</sup> EDITION 1993)

Add the following as item (38) to Schedule-VII:

" Gold Pass may be issued to serving MR/MOS(R)/DMR for undertaking journeys on official duty. For journeys otherwise than on duty, six sets of I-AC Complimentary Cheque Passes per year may be issued to serving MR/MOS(R)/DMR for self & eligible members of family as defined in the Railway Servants(Pass) Rules, 1986. Other conditions of travel will be the same as applicable to serving Board Members."
