TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE OF CANDIDATES RECRUITED AS ASSISTANT DIVISIONAL MEDICAL OFFICERS IN THE INDIAN RAILWAY MEDICAL SERVICE

1. PAY:

The post of Assistant Divisional Medical Officer in the Indian Railway Medical Service is in Group 'A' Junior Scale in level 10 of Pay Matrix of Railway Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2016 (Pre Revised PB-3, Rs. 15,600 – 39,100/- with Grade Pay of Rs. 5,400/-) and it carries Non-Practicing Allowance as per rules/orders in force from time to time. Private practice is prohibited. The candidate will be bound to observe the orders which the Ministry of Railways or any other competent authority may issue from time to time restricting or prohibiting private practice by him/her.

2. PROBATION:

The candidate will be appointed on probation for a period of one year which may be extended by the Government if considered necessary. On satisfactory completion of the probation, candidate will be eligible for confirmation in the Junior Scale of the Indian Railway Medical Service.

2(1) CHARACTER CERTIFICATE:

The candidate will be required to furnish a latest Character Certificate signed by two gazetted officers while reporting for duty.

3. REFUND OF COST OF TRAINING:

If for any reason, which in the opinion of the Government, are not beyond the control of the probationer, a probationer who wishes to withdraw from training during probation, he/she shall be liable to refund the whole cost of the Institutionalized training imparted to him/her during probation (the cost of Institutionalized training for one month at current rate is Rs. 35,000/-) and any other money paid to him/her during the period of such training. For this purpose, he/she will execute a bond as in the proforma enclosed.

4. TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENT DURING PROBATION:

4.1 The appointment of probationers can be terminated after one month's notice in writing by either side during the period of probation in terms of Rule 301(3) of the Indian Railway Establishment Code, Volume I. Such notice is, however, not required in cases of dismissal or removal as disciplinary measure after compliance with the provisions of Clause (2) of the Article 311 of the Constitution and compulsory retirement due to mental or physical incapacity.

4.2 If in the opinion of the Government, the work and conduct of a probationer is unsatisfactory or shows that he/she is unlikely to become an efficient medical officer, the Government may discharge him/her forthwith.

4.3 Failure to pass the Departmental Examinations may result in termination of service. Failure to pass the examination in Hindi of an approved standard within the period of probation shall involve liability to termination of services.

4.4 The Government, however, reserves the right to terminate the services forthwith in terms of Rules 301(4) of the Indian Railway Establishment Code, Volume-I, as amended from time to time.

5. TRAINING:

The candidate will undergo training as prescribed by the Ministry of Railways and is required to pass the prescribed Departmental Examinations.

6. PROVIDENT FUND AND PENSION:

The candidate shall be governed by the 'New Pension System' effective from 01/01/2004, as per orders of the Government.

7. LEAVE:

The candidate will be eligible for leave in accordance with the leave rules as applicable to the railway officers from time to time.

7.1 However, if the IRMS probationer is already admitted to a PG Course and he/she wishes to pursue the same, he/she has the option of completing the joining formalities at NAIR, and make a written request for grant of Extra Ordinary Leave (EOL) for pursuing PG course along with proof of admission in PG/Bonafide Certificate. In such an event, he/she can be considered for grant of Extra Ordinary Leave (EOL), i.e, Leave Without Pay by the Director General/NAIR, for completing the Post Graduation in Medical Sciences for the balance duration of the course subject to a maximum period of 3 years. However, grant of EOL for pursuing Post Graduation is not a matter of right and this is sanctioned by the competent authority in administrative interest on case to case basis. Further, the probationer is required to execute a bond for grant of EOL for pursuing PG course.

7.2 If for any reason, the IRMS probationer is required to report for joining on a Zonal Railway before undergoing foundation training at NAIR, the request for grant of EOL for completing Post Graduation course as mentioned in Para 7.1 above, may be made to the General Manager of the concerned Railway.

8. PASSES AND P.T.Os:

The candidate will be eligible for free Railway Passes and Privilege Ticket Orders in accordance with Rules in force from time to time.

8.1 However, those candidates who are availing EOL before completing the training at NAIR as per Para 7.1 or as per Para 7.2 above, shall not avail the facility of free Railway Passes and Privilege Ticket Orders during the period of such EOL.

9. DECLARATION ABOUT MARRIAGE:

Under the rules, a person having more than one spouse living or a woman whose marriage is void by reason of her husband having a wife living at the time of such marriage, is not eligible for appointment to the Railway Service. The Government of India, may however, if satisfied that there are special grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this provision. The offer of appointment is, therefore, conditional on the candidate's signing a declaration in the form enclosed and submitting the same to the Director General/NAIR or GM, as the case may be, at the time of joining. In case, the candidate does not satisfy this condition and wishes to be exempted from the operation of this provision, he/she shall furnish the full facts of this case to the Ministry of Railways immediately to enable the Government to take a decision in the matter.

10. LIABILITY TO SERVE IN DEFENCE SERVICES:

The candidate, appointed to the Indian Railway Medical Service shall, if so required, be liable to serve in any Defence Service or post connected with the Defence of India for a period of not less than four years including the period spent on training, if any, provided that such person:-

- a. shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of 10 years from the date of such appointment;
- b. shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of 40 years.

11. GENERAL

The candidate will be governed in respect of all matters, whether specifically provided for herein or otherwise by the Recruitment Rules for Indian Railway Medical Service and the provisions of the Indian Railway Codes and the extant orders as issued/amended from time to time.

BOND FOR IRMS PROBATIONERS PROCEEDING ON EXTRAORDINARY LEAVE FOR PURSUING POST GRADUATION COURSES
