**Sub.:-** Cash Award policy for Indian Railways sportspersons, including coaches and officials, for their outstanding achievements in the field of sports.

Railway Sports Promotion Board (RSPB) have decided to introduce a uniform Cash Award policy for all players, coaches and officials of Indian Railways; for their outstanding achievements in the field of sports.

In supersession of all earlier instructions on the subject matter, the Cash Award policy as mentioned in the Annexure, shall be applicable to all serving Indian Railways sportspersons, including coaches and officials; for their outstanding achievements in the field of sports.

This issues with the approval of Board(MS) and President/RSPB.

**NOTE :**

- (i) The sportspersons representing the country in the Olympic Games shall also be eligible for a Cash Award of Rs.3,00,000 each.
- (ii) The Cash Award mentioned above is for Individual(Singles) events. **For team games, doubles, relay and group events; each medal winner shall be eligible for half of the Cash Award amount**, mentioned above.
- (iii) Only Railway sportspersons who represent the Country or Indian Railways teams in the above mentioned International/National championships/events or Railway/Unit team in All India Railway Championships; shall be eligible for the Cash Awards.
- (iv) If a sportsperson wins medals both in team and individual events, by playing separately in these events, he/she shall be eligible for cash awards for medal winning performance on each event. In the games (like Athletics, Boxing, Wrestling, etc.), where team championship is decided on the basis of individual medals, Cash Award for individual medals shall only be given.
- (v) (a) Chess players achieving the title of International Grand Master or International Master, are eligible for Cash Award of Rs. 5,00,000 and Rs. 1,00,000 respectively.
- (b) Official Chess Olympiad shall be treated at par with the World Championships, for the purpose of Cash Award.

- (vi) In Badminton, Table Tennis and Tennis; top three Indian Railways players in current All India Annual Rankings in Senior Category, shall be eligible for a Cash Award of Rs.10,000 / Rs.6,000 / Rs.4,000 respectively; subject to the condition that their said Ranking should not be below 10 position.
- (vii) Cricket (Men & Women) - Individual performance in Senior National Cricket Championships will be eligible for following Cash Award, in addition to award for team championship, if any:

- (viii) (a) The coach of a medal winning team or individual player will be eligible for half (1/2) of the amount of Cash Award admissible to a player. For this purpose the amount of Cash Award for highest medal, won by the team or by an individual, shall be taken into account.
- (b) In case more than one coach is attached with a team, the amount of cash award admissible shall be divided equally amongst the all the coaches, but the share of each coach shall not be less than Rs.10,000 / Rs.6,000 / Rs.4,000 for International Championships and Rs.5,000 / Rs.3,000 / Rs.2,000 for National level championships; for winning Gold/Silver/Bronze medal respectively, by team or an individual.
- (c) For a championship, coaches shall be eligible for only one Cash Award. The coaches appointed by National Sports Federations / Indian Olympics Association with Indian teams or by the RSPB with Indian Railways teams and who have actually performed duties during Coaching Camps/ Championships, will only be eligible for Cash Award.
- (ix) (a) Manager of a medal winning team (whether Individual or Team medal) shall be eligible for a Cash Award of Rs.10,000 / Rs.6,000 / Rs.4,000 for International Championships and Rs.5,000 / Rs.3,000 / Rs.2,000 for National level championships.
- (b) Official(s) nominated by National Sports Federations / Indian Olympics Association or by the RSPB and who have actually performed duties during Coaching Camps/ Championships, shall only be eligible for Cash Awards.
- (c) For National level championships, not more than two Cash Awards in a financial year shall be granted to an official, even though he/she would be attached with more than two medal winner teams.

- (x) Players creating a new meet record, will be eligible for an additional Cash Award equal to the half of the amount as mentioned above in the table for Gold Medals.
- (xi) Players creating a new National / Asian / World Record will be eligible for an additional Cash Award of Rs.25,000 / Rs.1,00,000 / Rs.2,00,000 respectively. If meet record and National/Asian/World record is created at the same time, only one cash award, whichever is higher, shall be admissible.
- (xii) The Railway sportspersons, coaches and officials shall be eligible for Pocket Allowances, only for the championship period, for participation in the above mentioned International Championships/events, to be held outside the Country. No other International championship/event shall be considered for this purpose.
- (xiii) Indian Railways sportspersons shall also be eligible for following cash incentives for winning the below mentioned National Awards / Sports Achievements:-

- (xiv) (a) For Cash Award to medal winners in All India Railway Championships as per this policy letter, RSPB will issue a consolidated cheque of total amount of Cash Award, in favour of the Sports Association of host Zonal Railway / Unit; before the start of the Championships.
- (b) The host Zonal Railway / Unit will issue separate cheques (account payee only) in favour of the medal winners, which should be given to medal winners along with the medals at the time of medal awarding ceremony. Railways will give a report of confirmation of the same to RSPB, immediately after the medal awarding ceremony.
