
Sub:- Supply of 500 ml/1000 ml packaged drinking water  
(PDW) bottle in Shatabdi trains.

In continuation of Board's letter dated: 27-05-1999 referred above, Ministry of Railways (Railway Board) with the concurrence of the Finance Directorate of Railway Board, have decided as under:-

- (a) Only Shatabdi trains with journey time upto 5 hrs. be provided 500ml bottles while Shatabdi trains having journey time of more than 5 hrs. be continued to be provided with 1000 ml packaged drinking water bottle.
- (b) The Maximum Retail Price of 500 ml PDW will be Rs. 8/- per bottle and the tentative transfer price will be Rs. 5.50/- per bottle.


