Annexure

Illustration of fare and service charge to be paid by IRCTC and the lump sum deposit to be deposited by them.

Eg. Sector: New Delhi – Jammu

Train no.: 12425

Class: 3AC

Full fare for each berth: ₹1185/-

Service charge = ₹296 (25% of the fare)

Total fare for each berth = ₹1481

Total amount to be paid by IRCTC for say, 10 berths = 1481×10
= ₹14810

The above said amount will be paid by IRCTC for each trip.

In addition, a lump sum deposit of ₹14810 (value of one single trip) will be deposited by IRCTC before the first trip of that package which shall be refunded on completion of the currency of the particular value added tour package.
