Sub: Freight Incentive Scheme for Incremental Traffic.

Please refer to ECR's letter No. ECR/CRM/FMS/04/FIS/Misc dated 27.06.2014 on the above cited subject, wherein certain clarification has been sought from Board regarding Freight Incentive Scheme for Incremental Traffic.

The matter has been examined in consultation with Finance (Commercial) Directorate of Ministry of Railways. The condition (3) of Para 4.4 of Rates Master Circular/FIS/2014/0 clearly stipulates that if a customer is dealing with more than one commodity at a single terminal (for example Cement & Clinker), then combined NTKMs from different commodities should be taken into consideration for deciding the eligibility under the scheme.

Since the guidelines are clear in this regard and there is no ambiguity, no further clarification is warranted.
