

Sub: Haulage Charge for movement of commodities in containers
Ref: Rates Circular No.67 of 2009 and Rates Circular No.30 of 2010

Please refer to Rates Circular No.67 of 2009 vide which Haulage rates for movement of containers in privately owned wagons has been notified. Further, Rates Circular No.30 of 2010 stipulates the guidelines for levy of Haulage Charge for movement of nine notified commodities in containers on the basis of 'Container Class Rate'.

The matter has been examined and it has been decided that in the case of domestic traffic, CTOs should declare the details of commodities loaded in containers in the forwarding note, irrespective of the fact whether it is charged on the basis of normal 'Haulage rate' or 'Container Class Rate'.

FOIS will make necessary software modification to capture the details of commodity declared by CTOs as per the classification done in Goods Tariff No.45 Pt.I Vol.II.
