Sub: Special Intensive Cleaning of Railway Stations by rotation for one day in a week.

Central Railway has started a very good practice of undertaking special intensive cleaning activity of any one station of each Division on every Sunday of the week. On this day, special intensive cleaning of toilets, stairs, FOBs, glass panes and stalls including dustbins of vendors, is taken up. Along with this, repairs to passenger amenity fittings like lights, fans, signages etc. are also taken up. Unwanted pockets of enclosures in the station are removed. With the traffic being less on Sundays, such special intensive cleaning activity is undertaken by closing of some of the entry points to stations. This is carried out by mobilising and deploying multiple teams of manpower and supervision. The effectiveness of this activity is monitored by inspection of Branch officers and ADRM/DRM of the division and the results achieved are documented /photographed. This effort has come up for all round appreciations.

All Zonal Railways are requested to advise their divisions immediately to start similar practice of Special Intensive Cleaning on any one day in a week convenient to them, by choosing the stations within their Division on rotation.
